The door to the main hall keeps on being left open during the Baby & Toddler session. We have lots of toddlers running about now and this door needs to be kept closed at all times for their safety. Can I please ask everyone to ensure that they close the door on their way in and out and also be vigilant when it has been left open to make an effort to close it.

At the end of the Baby & Toddler session, during tidy up time, children have been finding their way into the toy cupboard. There are large items being carried in and out of the toy

cupboard during this time and there are lots of heavy items both on the floor and shelves which can easily topple over if knocked or pulled on by a child. Please help us to ensure the safety of your children by keeping them out of the toy cupboard at all times.
